TBC Internet Study Café

The purpose is provide a location where students can make use of Wi-Fi to complete school assignments, along with study and any tutoring provided.

Parents and Students must register with Trinity Baptist Church (TBC) for use of the TBC Internet Study Café in order to reserve their spot. There are a limited number of spaces, and reservations will be taken on a first come first serve basis. A waiting list can be provided.

Student Use of Technology Agreement and Release of Liability Form

Trinity Baptist (TBC) authorizes students to use wifi owned and provided by Trinity Baptist for study and classwork purposes. The use of Trinity Baptist wifi, or any other provided technology, is a privilege permitted at the discretion of TBC and is subject to the conditions and restrictions set forth in applicable TBC policies, administrative regulations, and this Acceptable Use Agreement. TBC reserves the right to suspend access at any time, without notice, for any reason.

TBC expects all students to use the TBC wifi, or any other technology offered, responsibly in order to avoid potential problems and liability. TBC may place reasonable restrictions on the sites, material, and/or information that students may access through the system.

Each student who is authorized to use TBC wifi and his/her parent/guardian shall sign this Acceptable Use Agreement as an indication that they have read and understand the agreement.

Definitions

TBC technology includes, but is not limited to, TBC computer network wireless computer networking technology (Wi-Fi). TBC technology may, in the future, and as needs arise, provide computers for student use at TBC facility.

Student Obligations and Responsibilities

Students are expected to use TBC technology safely, responsibly, and for educational purposes only.

Students are prohibited from using TBC Wi-Fi or other technological devices for improper purposes, including, but not limited to:

1. Access, post, display, or otherwise use material that is discriminatory, libelous, defamatory, obscene, sexually explicit, or disruptive.
2. Bully, harass, intimidate, or threaten other students, staff, or other individuals ("cyberbullying").

3. Disclose, use, or disseminate personal identification information (such as name, address, telephone number, Social Security number, or other personal information) of another student, staff member, or other person with the intent to threaten, intimidate, harass, or ridicule that person.
4. Infringe on copyright, license, trademark, patent, or other intellectual property rights.
5. If at a future date, TBC provides computers for use during the scheduled study time
-Intentionally disrupt or harm TBC technology or other TBC operations (such as destroying equipment, placing a virus on computers, adding or removing a computer program without permission from a TBC personnel, changing settings on computers).
6. Install unauthorized software. (if TBC provides use of computers)
7. "Hack" into the system to manipulate data of TBC or other users.
8. Engage in or promote any practice that is unethical or violates any law or TBC policy, administrative regulation, or TBC practice.

Privacy

Since the use of TBC technology is intended for educational purposes, students shall not have any expectation of privacy in any use of TBC technology.

TBC reserves the right to monitor and record all use of TBC technology, including, but not limited to, access to the Internet or social media, communications sent or received from TBC technology, or other uses. Such monitoring/recording may occur at any time without prior notice for any legal purposes including, but not limited to, record retention and distribution and/or investigation of improper, illegal, or prohibited activity. Students should be aware that, in most instances, their use of TBC technology (such as web searches and emails) cannot be erased or deleted.

Personally Owned Devices

Students using their personally owned device to access TBC technology, he/she shall abide by all applicable TBC policies, administrative regulations, and this Acceptable Use Agreement. Any such use of a personally owned device may subject the contents of the device and any communications sent or received on the device to disclosure pursuant to a lawful subpoena or public records request.

Reporting

If a student becomes aware of any security problem (such as any compromise of the confidentiality of any login or account information) or misuse of TBC technology, he/she shall immediately report such information to TBC personnel.

Consequences for Violation

Violations of the law, TBC policy, or this agreement may result in revocation of a student's access to TBC technology which may include suspension or expulsion for TBC technology. In addition, violations of the law, TBC policy, or this agreement may be reported to law enforcement agencies as appropriate.

Student Acknowledgment

I have received, read, understand, and agree to abide by this Acceptable Use Agreement and other applicable laws and TBC policies and regulations governing the use of TBC technology. I understand that there is no expectation of privacy when using TBC technology. I further understand that any violation may result in loss of user privileges, disciplinary action, and/or appropriate legal action.
